

Exciting News About Christ the Saviour Seminary!

His Eminence, Metropolitan Gregory, has given his blessing for the Chancery to release a progress report on (1) The Seminary Accreditation Committee, and on (2) building progress on the present Seminary being relocated to the Diocesan property on Garfield Street across from the Chancery and Cathedral in Johnstown, PA.

(Item 1) In September of 2023, His Eminence appointed a Committee of Six including His Eminence, Seminary President; Very Rev. Protopresbyter Frank P. Miloro, Chancellor and Seminary Dean; Reverend Dr. Marc Wisnosky, Seminary professor and Committee Chair; Very Rev. Peter Zarynow, Board of Trustees; Reverend Michael Rustick, Seminary Prefect; and Dr.Sharon Peifer Board of Trustees. This Committee has been working for nearly a year with the task of completing the "Application for New Program-Granting Program - Approved Institution" required by the Commonwealth. This application is specifically for institutions within Pennsylvania which are recognized by the Commonwealth to grant a degree and wishing to add a new degree program. Once fully completed this month, and with the Diocesan Board of Trustees approval, the Seminary Accreditation Committee will submit the application to the Department of Education. The Committee's hope is that this new Master of Divinity Program will be approved in 2025 along with the projected completion of the new Seminary building project.

(Item 2) Architect Jeff Haman of Jeffrey Hamon Architects, Inc, Windber, PA, has completed all architectural drawings, including Mechanical, Electrical, Plumbing and Fire Protection. Final Design of the structural system is underway. Land Use Planning documents as well as stormwater management have been submitted for city permits, as well as determining with utility companies the size and location of all utility upgrades. By the end of this month, the architect and structural engineer will have completed the final structural design together with interior design of finishes and fixtures for the dormitory space, library, classrooms and Chapel. Once completed, bids will be solicited in August.

There is huge excitement in Johnstown! There is much yet to be done, but our architect has committed to completion by Spring/early Summer 2025. Pray with us for the success of this major project.

| 346-4457) when a family member is admitted to the hospital, or to request a home visit. Hospitals do not call to alert the parish when someone is admitted. Marriages are solemnized on Saturdays or Sundays. Circumstances may require a dispensation from the diocesan bishop. Consult the pastor at least six months in advance and before any plans have been made for the wedding reception. Marriages cannot be celebrated during the fasting seasons of the church, or on Fridays. Baptisms are usually scheduled on Saturdays or Sundays. Consult the pastor. Two godparents (godfather and godmother) are required, at least one of whom must be a practicing Orthodox Christian in good standing at an Orthodox parish, and the other (at least) a practicing, baptized Christian. | Church Funerals are, under ordinary circumstances, provided for practicing Orthodox Christians who are current in their spiritual and material obligations to the parish; otherwise, the funeral service is conducted at the funeral home. The Church does not permit cremation. Parishioners in "good standing" are those Orthodox Christians who, as members of Saint John's Orthodox Church, strive to live according to the teachings of the Orthodox Church; participate in the life of the parish through regular church attendance, regular reception of Holy Communion and periodic Holy Confession (and receive these sacraments no less than once a year); if married, having been married in the Orthodox Church; and financially support the parish (especially through an annual "pledge"). Prospective members and returning members are asked to fill out an application form, copies of which are available in the church office. |
