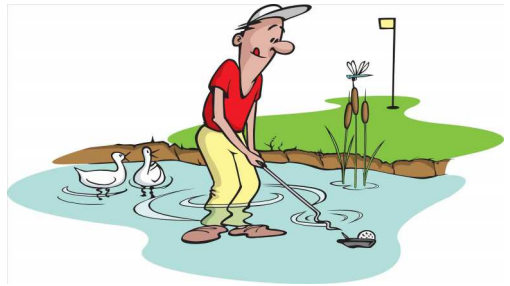
GOLF SCRAMBLE NOTES
